ROAD TRAFFIC

THE TRUNK ROADS (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NO 3) ORDER 1976

Made 17TH FEBRUARY 1976

Coming into Operation 8TH MARCH 1976

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by section 74(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (a), as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 (b), and now vested in him (c), and of all other enabling powers, hereby orders as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Roads (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 3) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 8TH MARCH 1976.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 (d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

That length of the London-Brighton Trunk Road (A23) known as Brighton Road, at Hooley in the District of Reigate and Banstead in the County of Surrey, which extends from a point 39 yards south of its junction with Dean Lane to a point 173 yards north of its junction with Star Bridge, (a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 1,334 yards).
